

Kunwinjku Language Online Course

BININJ KUNWOK REGIONAL LANGUAGE CULTURE ⁺ CENTRE Bangkerreng 2025 6 weeks commencing 24 February 2025

This course is a practical introduction to the Indigenous Australian language— Kunwinjku, which is spoken throughout Kakadu National Park and western Arnhem Land. It is designed to develop basic speaking, listening, reading and writing skills at an introductory level, and to develop a knowledge and understanding of the relation between language, culture and society in the community of the speakers. The course explains aspects of grammar and everyday practical conversational strategies. Course materials are online in a series of weekly units designed by linguists with teaching qualifications, in collaboration with native speaking language specialists with many years of teaching experience. Each week two live Zoom tutorials are offered with Kunwinjku native speakers. These are usually offered at 5:00 - 6:00pm NT time on Tuesdays and Thursdays.



To enrol, you pay the course fees online via our online payment gateway. The course is \$495 including GST. Fees are used to pay our Bininj language teachers and for administration of the course. Once you have paid you will receive an email in the week before the course with login details and an invitation to our teaching platform <u>Google</u> <u>Classroom</u> where you can interact with teachers and other students and complete weekly assignments.
